### THIRTY-FIRST LEGISLATURE OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

An Act providing an appropriation from the Tourism Advertising Revolving Fund to the Office of the Governor, Virgin Islands Police Department, the Department of Public Works, the Virgin Islands Waste Management Authority and the Department of Tourism during the Fiscal Year October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:*

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding 33V.I.C. §3072 (c), the following sums, or so much of the sums as may be necessary, are appropriated in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, from the Tourism Advertising Revolving Fund to the Office of the Governor for the Bureau of Economic Research to conduct traveler exit surveys and other tourism and economic studies and activities, to the Virgin Islands Police Department for police operations on St. Thomas, St. John and St. Croix, to the Department of Public Works and the Waste Management Authority to fund various festival clean-ups and to the Department of Tourism for various festivals in Fiscal Year 2016


