- (1) Centurion Security Systems in the amount of \$45,648.40 to pay outstanding service call invoices;
- (2) Lutheran Social Services in the amount of \$35,785.72 to pay outstanding invoices for services rendered under the Early Head Start Program through the provision of Act No. 7414 for the period of October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2013;
- (3) Virgin Islands Behavioral Services, Inc. in the amount of \$39,563.79 to pay outstanding invoices for services rendered under the Juvenile Wrap Around Services, which is a therapeutic crisis program for adolescent youth ages 13-17 years old; and
- (4) Virgin Islands Behavioral Services, Inc. in the amount of \$337,261.88 to pay outstanding invoices for services rendered under Medical Mental Health for young people who are temporary wards at the Youth Rehabilitation Center.

Any member of a Board of Election must resign his position on the board as a condition of seeking any other public office.
