An Act making appropriations for the operation of the Government of the Virgin Islands during the fiscal year October 1, 2015, to September 30, 2016

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*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:*

**SECTION 1.** The sums listed in this section, or so much of the sums as sufficient to accomplish the purposes specified, are appropriated and authorized to be paid from any funds in the General Fund of the Treasury of the Virgin Islands and are available for the fiscal year, October 1, 2015, to September 30, 2016.

**SECTION 3.** Every non-government recipient of a grant of funding under section 2 is subject to the financial disclosure requirements under title 2, section 29 of the Virgin Islands Code.

**SECTION 4.** Title 33 Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 2, chapter 87, section 2456, subsection (b) is amended by inserting "and one percent of all real property taxes collected when two or more real property tax bills are issued in one calendar year, beginning with the calendar year 2007" after "per annum".

**SECTION 5.** Act No. 7081, section 2, subsection (I) [sic], paragraph (4), is amended by striking "\$200,000 and inserting \$100,000" and by adding a subsection "Ia" immediately under paragraph (4) to read as follows:

"Ia. The Department of Planning and Natural Resources \$100,000".

**SECTION 6.** Title 17 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 5, section 44, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding subsections (b), (c) and (d) to read as follows:

"(b) The Department of Education shall employ one or more persons with general maintenance skills at every public school with an enrollment of not fewer than 250 students. The maintenance person need not be licensed in a particular trade to carry out general maintenance and minor repairs, but must demonstrate actual physical basic skills, ability and knowledge of general maintenance.

(c) Schools with an enrollment of fewer than 250 students may share a maintenance person, however a maintenance person may not be permanently assigned to more than two schools on a regular or permanent basis.

(d) Schools that provide vocational education may require students to provide routine maintenance at the school in their respective vocation under the supervision of the teacher as part of the semester grade. No student may be required to perform maintenance outside of the student's vocation and ability."

**SECTION 7.** The Director of Motor Vehicles may issue a Centennial License Plate for the year 2015 which expires five years after issuance. A fee of \$10 must be added to the regular registration fee. Fifty percent of the added fee of \$10 must be covered over to the Centennial Commission, and the other fifty percent must be retained by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

**SECTION 8.** For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, the Government of the Virgin Islands shall pay 1.16 percent of the 35 percent of the insurance premium charged to the employees of the Government of the Virgin Islands under the Group Health Insurance Program up to an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.

Thus passed by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands on September 29, 2015.
